Role Purpose

The Box Project, run by Chester Pride, is doing something great in Chester – giving out free condoms and menstrual cycle products at various spots around town. Launched in 2020 in partnership with HCRG, the local Sexual Health provider, the discreet packages contain information on HCRG and a comprehensive list of support helplines, covering issues such as drug and alcohol-related concerns and domestic abuse. This initiative plays a vital role in supporting the community's health and wellbeing, addressing immediate needs, and connecting individuals with essential resources.

Chester Pride is currently recruiting a Box Project Champion (or two!) to further expand and enhance the impact of this essential service. That's where you come in!

Tasks and Responsibilities

- Create Box Project packages with condoms, menstrual cycle products and advice and resource packs;
- Track and organise inventory;
- Distribute and replenish packages at our partner venues;
- Empty bar shakers at partner venues and make a record of moneys raised;
- Maintain a great working relationship with our venues;
- Where possible, be proactive in encouraging other businesses to sign up to the service.

Expectations

- Undertake a volunteer induction process that will include role specific training;
- Report directly to your volunteer manager;
- Adhere to Chester Pride's code of conduct;
- Promote Chester Pride's ethos and values;

Personal Specification

- Passion for supporting the LGBTQ+ community and promoting inclusivity;
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills;
- Comfortable with carrying boxes and walking/driving across Chester;
- Able to use initiative to complete tasks without always being told;
- Committed to a regular fortnightly schedule of your own choosing, for a maximum of four hours.
